Cart Etiquette – please do not drive over the rough ©

Eynesbury has been designed to give you, the golfer, the opportunity to enjoy your round of golf via the use of golf carts. We have also designed and built a very unique golf course that is fully irrigated with recycled water, not just on the tees, fairways, greens and surrounds, but our magnificent fescue rough as well. This rough is extremely sensitive and we ask that you PLEASE strictly keep to the paths provided and to the closely mown couch fairways.



The first cut of rough is the fescue grass, not couch, as with many other golf courses. If you drive your cart over this on a hot day, the fescue may burn off. If you need to search for, or play your ball from the first or indeed the long rough, please park the cart on the edge of the fairway and walk to your ball.

Please respect the golf course, and leave it as you would like to have it left for you.



Staff are instructed to educate all cart users to keep to the cart paths and the closely mown couch fairways.

Staff are further instructed to remove the keys from carts of offenders who are damaging the golf course.
